WHO CAN APPLY?

Any current student at one of the 37 Minnesota State colleges or universities (students attending private colleges or the University of Minnesota system are not eligible); members of the LeadMN Governing Council are ineligible for the LeadMN scholarships.

WHEN SHOULD YOU APPLY?

Fall semester enrollment period: November 2-April 1, midnight.
Spring semester enrollment period: April 2-November 1, midnight.

LEADMN LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

- For Minnesota State two-year college or four-year university undergraduate students;
- Must demonstrate strong leadership skills and a commitment to serving others;
- Must have a 2.5 GPA or higher;
- Graduate and PSEO students are ineligible;
- Awarded for fall and spring semesters.

JAMES H. AND MARYAN G. MCCORMICK LEADERSHIP ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

- For Minnesota State students pursuing a certificate, undergraduate or advance degree;
- Must demonstrate leadership in academics, extracurricular activities and community service;
- Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher;
- PSEO students are ineligible;
- Awarded for spring semester.

DR. STEVE AND DARLA FRANTZ LEADERSHIP ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

- For Minnesota State students who demonstrate leadership in academics, extracurricular activities and community or national service;
- Priority will be given to those who are serving or have served in good standing in any branch of the United States Military or other U.S. national service and have exhausted federal and state service related education benefits excluding the Minnesota GI Bill;
- Must have a 2.5 GPA or higher;
- Graduate students are eligible;
- PSEO students are ineligible;
- Awarded for fall semester.

JOHN KENNETH NIEMI ENDOWED MEMORIAL TOOL FUND SCHOLARSHIP

- For Minnesota State technical college/technical program students who must purchase tools to complete the technical course;
- Preference will be given to students enrolled in HVAC or a hands-on trade or construction course of study;
- Must have a 2.0 GPA or higher;
- PSEO students are eligible;
- Awarded for fall and spring semesters.

MORRIE ANDERSON SCHOLARSHIP

- For Minnesota State students enrolled in a technical program at one of the technical or consolidated colleges;
- Must have a 2.0 GPA or higher;
- PSEO students are eligible;
- Awarded for fall semester.

IRJA SUNDGREN PRATT ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

- For Minnesota State students who are enrolled in one of the five two-year Northeast Higher Education District (NHED) institutions. NHED consists of Hibbing Community College, Itasca Community College, Mesabi Range College, Rainy River Community College and Vermilion Community College;
- Must have completed at least one semester of course-work at a NHED college;
- Must have a 2.0 GPA or higher;
- PSEO students are eligible;
- Awarded for spring semester.

PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO STUDENTS WHO MEET THIS CRITERIA:

- Graduated from a Ramsey or Roseau County high school; (a special preference will be given to graduates of Greenbush Middle River School District);
- Must demonstrate financial need;
- Enrolled in a technical course of study;
- Have a grade point average of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale;
- Be a Minnesota resident.

APPLICANTS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED IF THEY ARE:

- A graduate student; or
- A PSEO student.

TO APPLY, APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- A letter of application/personal letter which includes and describes the applicant's:
 - Academic goals;
 - Career goals; and
 - Personal goals.
- A statement of need, describing why they need the scholarship;
- One letter of recommendation from a college/university staff;
- A copy of their transcript (does not need to be an official transcript).
