About the Course

This course is intended for individuals who must be CPR and AED certified for school and employment in any healthcare field. Topics covered in this course include:

- Rescue breathing
- CPR for adults, children and infants
- Two-person CPR
- Use of a Bag Valve Mask (BVM)
- Care of an obstructed airway
- How to use an Automatic External Defibrillator

We combine American Heart Association (AHA) video-based teaching, verbal instruction and hands-on skills-practice using manikins. Successful completion of the course will include a written test and a skills-based practical evaluation by the instructor.

CPR Certification cards will be issued by email 1-2 weeks after successful course completion.
