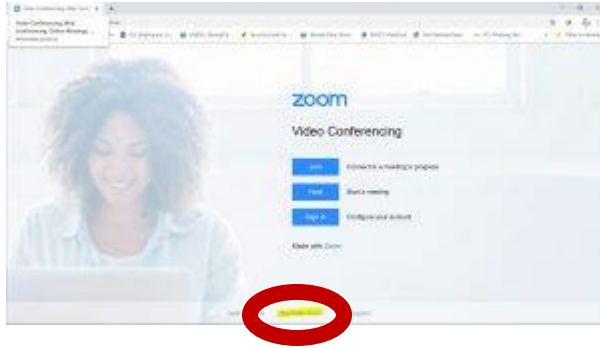


# How to install the Zoom client and sign in for the first time.

1. Go to the following website: <https://minnstate.zoom.us>
2. At the bottom of the page click **Download Client**.



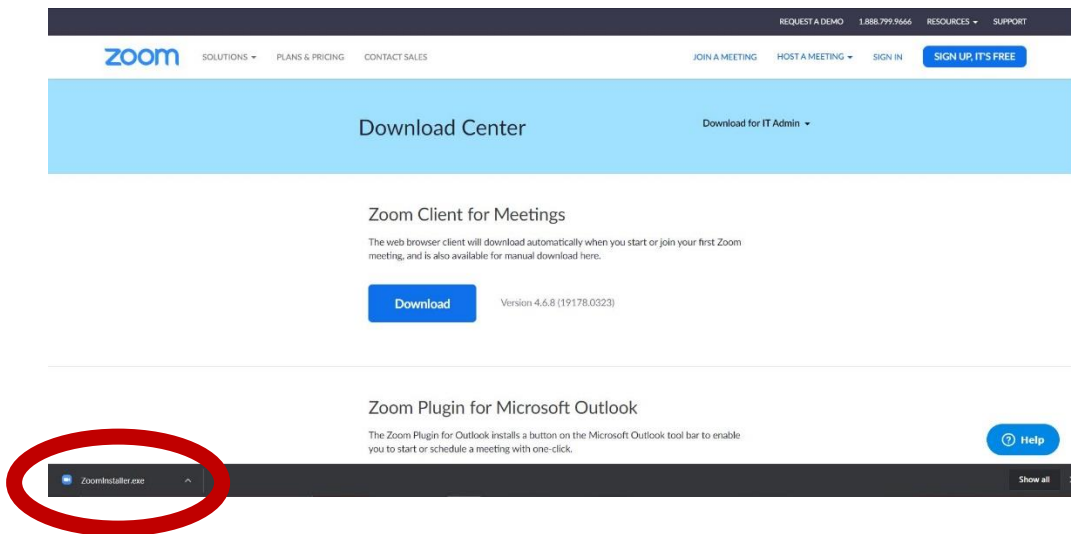
3. This will open the Download Center, under Zoom Client for Meetings -- click **Download**

## Zoom Client for Meetings

The web browser client will download automatically when you start or join your first Zoom meeting, and is also available for manual download here.



4. The download file will appear in the bottom left corner -- Save and run the file.

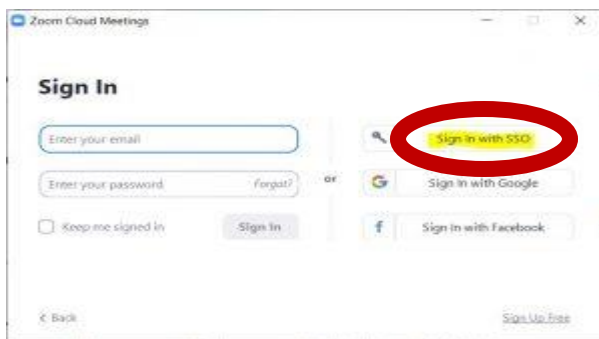


5. When a pop-up window prompts the question –  
Do you want to allow this app to make changes to your device?  
Click **YES** button

6. Then click **Sign In**.



6. On the Zoom Sign in screen, select **Sign in with SSO**.



7. On the Sign in with SSO dialog box, type **Minnstate** in the Company Domain box and then click **Continue** button.



8. A browser window will open and you will be prompted to type your **StarID and StarID password**. Click the **Sign on** button.

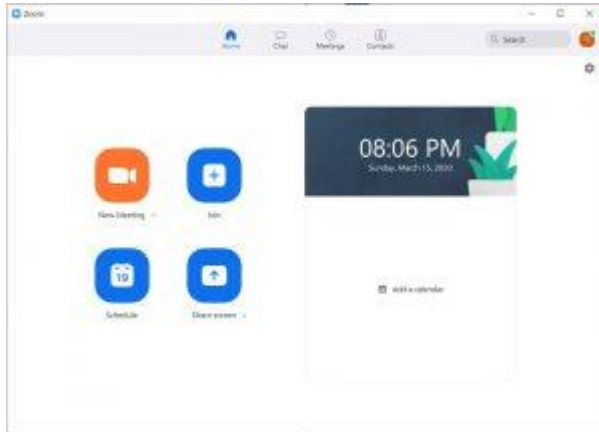

9. This will open the Launch Application box.
