Other courses that we offer are considered to be occupational or too technical in nature to receive normal consideration for transfer. Partial credit may be awarded for successful completion of these courses depending on where you are transferring to. Within Minnesota, you can usually transfer up to sixteen credits of occupational coursework unless you transferring into a similar program at that institution, in which case you may receive additional credit. Transfer of credit to out-of-state institutions is not assured unless we have a consortium agreement with that institution. Please check with a counselor or advisor if you have any questions about transfer.

Developmental courses (those numbered below 1000) are not intended for transfer.
