



Boiler Engineer Exam Prep

Course Description

This 9-week course is designed to prepare the boiler operator or those preparing for employment as a boiler operator to take either the Minnesota Low Pressure (C Level) or Minnesota High Pressure (Levels A and B) Boiler Exam for the following classes:

- Special Engineer
- 2nd Class Engineer
- 1st Class Engineer
- Chief Engineer

The contents include: low pressure – valves, steam traps, pumps, flame safeguards, burners, safety valves, boiler room safety, and hot water boilers. High pressure – condensers, steam engines, mathematical formulas, boiler room safety and hot water boilers.
